### **Everyone's Happy in the Wool Game This Week!**

The roller coaster ride continued for wool this week; as we forecast last week a lower A\$ would mean a dearer wool market. The A\$ lost another cent over the week and it translated directly into higher wool prices. All categories benefited; merino types were around 2 to 3% dearer while crossbred improved by around 1.5% all under the
